Assumption of Risk/Waiver of Liability/Indemnity Agreement

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, regulated the congregation of certain groups of people.

The Salesian Family Youth Center (SFYC) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the SFYC cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the SFYC could increase your risk and your child(ren)'s risk of contracting COVID-19, and spreading it to family members or other contacts.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the SFYC and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the SFYC may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, SFYC employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)'s attendance at the SFYC or participation in SFYC programming. On my behalf, and on behalf of my children, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, indemnify, and hold harmless the SFYC, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind by any person or entity arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release and indemnity agreement includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the SFYC, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any SFYC program.

Who is able to attend?

Children ages 4 to 13 are able to attend Camp Savio.

Special Events:

- ✓ **Beach Days** Three Thursdays during camp season
- ✓ **Special Field Trips** On Tuesdays July 5th, and 19th Camp Savio will be going on field trips in the morning. Campers need to provide their own lunch.
- ✓ **Masses** Every Friday at 10:00 AM Holy Mass will be celebrated for campers and counselors. Relatives are always welcome to come.
- ✓ **Family Night** On Friday July 29th Camp will end at 11:30 AM Because at 7:00 P.M., Camp Savio will host our annual Talent Show, more information to come depending on COVID conditions
- ✓ **Overnighter** Starting right after the Talent Show, we will host an overnighter for those children who want to spend the night here at Camp Savio. Our overnighter will go all through the night and end Saturday morning at 7:00 AM, more information to come depending on COVID conditions
- ✓ **8th graders** Every Wednesday, the boys' and girls' grades will be having different events or field trips to different places. Those trips and events can be canceled by the CYM as is necessary.

CDC Guidelines Being Followed:

The guidelines have been changing constantly. None the less, all guidelines are followed from <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/schools-childcare>

1. Each room will be sanitized before entry/after exit of the group.
2. Children will be encouraged and asked to wash hands frequently throughout the day.
3. Children are also asked to bring their own water bottles to avoid using water fountains.
4. The usage of masks will be required or not according to the CDC guidelines.

Note: we will be updating the guidelines as required by CDC.

Registration:

You can register your child(ren) by going to the Parish Office. The \$35 registration fee per child must be paid at St. Dominic Savio before/until June 1st. On June 2nd the registration fee will be \$75. On June 26th registration fee will be \$100.

List of Costs:

For all of our services the following fees must be paid in full:

- ✓ **Registration:**
 - \$ 35 **non-refundable** if registered until June 1st
 - \$ 75 **non-refundable** beginning June 2nd
 - \$ 100 **non-refundable** beginning June 26th
- ✓ **Weekly Payment:**
 - \$ 135 per week per child (Transitional Kindergarten – 7th grade)
 - \$ 190 per week per child (8th grade) this price includes the fees for the special field trips.
- ✓ **Family Promotion:**
 - If there are two siblings, the cost is \$ 220 per week
 - If there are three or more siblings, the cost is \$ 290 per week
 - Add \$ 55 per week for each child in 8th grade
 - **Note:** the only way to have access to this promotion is by showing the birth certificate. However, if your children participated last year, this requirement is not necessary.
- ✓ **Advanced Promotion:**
 - If paid in full for 5 weeks, the price is \$ 600 plus registration, this payment must be done before June 15th. Add \$ 55 per week for each child in 8th grade

(These prices include a Camp T-Shirt, field trips, and lunch Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.)

Fieldtrip days Families need to provide their own food!

About the prices!

Our commitment is to keep our summer camp affordable. We have not raised the prices since 2016. Considering each year's inflation in these last six years the accumulated inflation is 21.47%, and we are only increasing our prices by 12.5%. Nonetheless, all our suppliers have raised their prices every year.

If you are experiencing economic hardships, please call the church office and set an appointment for financial aid. Before this meeting, please make sure you have any proof of income.

Dress Code:

It is very important that boys and girls wear appropriate attire. We ask you to please consider the following:

Campers: No short shorts, No tank tops, No sandals or flip-flops, No baggy pants or shorts. No obscene writing or displays on shirts, no sandals or flip-flops.

Important notices and reminders:

- ✓ When making weekly payments, all payments must be made in the parish office the Friday before the camp week starts. The office is open 10am - 1pm and 2pm-7pm on Friday's. Please ask for proof of your payment.
- ✓ There are absolutely no refunds for any reason.
- ✓ On the last week of camp, no checks will be accepted, and all payments must be made by the Friday before the last week of camp.
